**Alter native Transportation:** Houston improves and expands existing pedestrian trails and bike paths providing alternative transportation options and ensuring safety and connectivity.

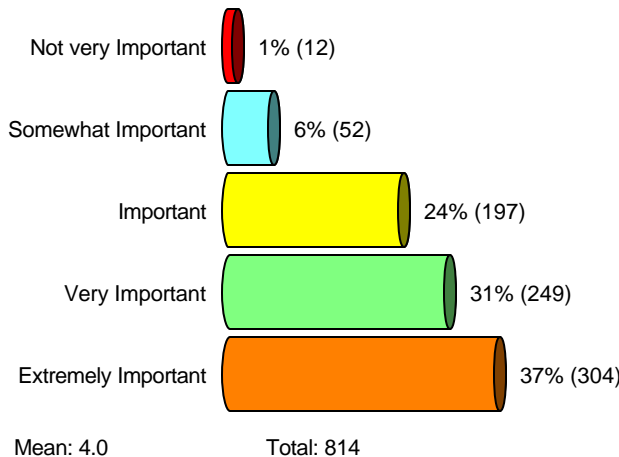
